

CURRENCIES OF THE FUTURE IN POPULAR SCIENCE FICTION

Society has recognized the need for interplanetary currencies long before PayPal Galactic was introduced. In fact, many storytellers have created currencies of the future within popular science fiction. Below is a list of some of the more recent ¹examples of currencies of the future depicted in science fiction universes that may be familiar.

- Currency: Galactic credit standard
 - Currency established on Sojourn (native races=Pylat and Muun)
 - One tenth of a credit=decicred
 - Main currency since the time of the Galactic Republic
 - Physical currency resembles metallic plate with varying patterns, reminiscent of a bar code
 - Small ingots introduced during Clone Wars as secondary physical form of credits
- Imperial credits come in increments of 0.1, 0.2, 0.5, 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50, 100, 200, 500, 1000, 2000 and 5000
- Example of use: Luke and Ben agree to pay Han Solo 2000 credits for a ride to Alderaan in the millennium falcon, with an extra 15000 promised upon their arrival.



- Currency: Credit Chit
 - Used by the Earth Alliance
 - Electronic system, similar to our interact system
 - The Centauri Republic use a different form of currency called 'Ducats'
 - Various other groups have their own currency (listed below)
 - Example of use: Vendor aboard the Babylon 5 ship accepts Credit Chit in exchange for goods.

Currency: <u>Cubit</u>

- Used throughout the 12 colonies
- Resembles small metallic plates
- Prominently shown in games of 'Pyramid' (gambling)
- Paper currency introduced in the 'reimagined' series of the show in 100, 500 and 1000 increments.

• Example of use: Desperate businessman attempts to bribe his way off Caprica.



• Currency: Space buck

- Physical spacebucks never shown but are mentioned periodically throughout the film.
- Example of us: Princess Vespa mentions how her fiancée hadn't even stayed for the money, instead taking his million spacebucks and running, to which Ring Roland replies 'he didn't take the million..."
- Vespa: Ha, didn't even stay for the wedding. Just took the million spacebucks and ran.
- Roland: he didn't take the million...



- Currency: Platinum
- Currency: Credit
 - Comes in paper and digital form
 - Money is all traceable and almost impossible to counterfeit
 - Since precious metal currency (silver, gold, platinum) are not traceable, they're not usable outside of the black market.
 - Example of use: Simon Tam notes the value of Ivoprovalyn as being at least 20 credits, or 50 platinum on the black market in the episode of Firefly titled 'Ariel'.



Currency: <u>Solari</u>

- o Official unit of the Imperium
- Although Solari is the official currency, true wealth is measured in how much Melange one has, having Solari being measured by how much of 'The Spice' it can purchase.
- Melange (fictional drug) commonly referred to as 'The Spice'
- Example of use: During their rule, House Harkonnen took 10 billion Solaris out of the



- Currency: Dollar Pound
 - Symbol is simply dollar sign followed by pound sign
 - Used throughout 12 colonies
 - Example of use: Lister checks his account and sees \$£0.06 shortly before leaving with the Jupiter Mining Corporation. After a 30,000 year stasis sleep, he finds it's grown to millions due to interest over the years. Ironically, he's later informed that a hydro bill from a single light being left on in his home has also stockpiled and he now owes millions as a result.
