

# Final Information for Postás Cup

## 12<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> April, 2008. Táborfalva

### Registration

- 10th April (Thursday) 5:30-6:30 p.m. Postás Sport Club's sports field (in the central building) Budapest 14th district, Róna u. 86-100.
- 12th April (Saturday) 9-11 a.m. in the Event Centre/Finish area
- entry fees must be paid at the Registration as per the entries.
- changes and new entries can be accepted only within the limits of the existing start list.
- entry fees at registration are (from 10th April):  
HUF 4.400/person/2days (MW 14-60),  
HUF 2.700/person/2days (MW -10,12, W60, M65-),  
HUF 900/person/day Open.
- the cost of changes after the entry closing date:  
HUF 500/person/2days, at Registration HUF 1.000/person/2days.
- changes must be submitted on the forms received at the Registration desk.
- the event will be run with the Sport Ident electronic punching system. Participants who do not have their own e-card may hire one at a fee of HUF 200/person/day at Registration. Free e-card hire for competitors under age 14.
- due to insufficient entries the classes below have been cancelled and the competitors transferred to the following classes:

F10C -> F12C  
F18C -> F18B  
N10C -> N12C  
N21A -> N21E  
N35Br ->N21Br

- the W60 category, thanks to the satisfactory number of entries, was divided into W60 and W65.
- entries for the OPEN category can be made at the Finish area without surcharge til 13 p.m. on Saturday, and til 11 a.m. on Sunday.

### Accommodation

Any accommodation can only be taken up by showing the voucher received at Registration. The accommodation fees have to be paid at Registration.

### Locations of the accommodations:

#### Student hostel:

The accommodations on Saturday can be taken up from 5pm and has to be vacated by 8.30 Sunday morning.

### Travelling to the event

The Finish and Event Centre are in the same place both days: 4km south-west from the junction of main road nr. 5 near Táborfalva.

### Getting to the Event Centre

Travelling by car drive to the junction of main road nr. 5 near Táborfalva. From there proceed on following the road towards the direction of Örkénytábor. The route will be signed. Parking will be near to the Finish, please park in the marked area!



**Base time:** Day 1: 12.00 pm, Day 2: 10.00 am

**Changing,** clothing depository and washing facilities: In the changing tents set up in the Finish area.

**To the starts:**

The starts situated in the same place on both days.

Distance to start: 570m marked with blue-white tape.

The start numbers received at Registration have to be worn.

**Map:**

1:7 500 and 1:10 000 scale, 5m contour intervals, 4 colour.

Surveyed in 2008 according to IOF specification. The color of the north lines is black. Plastic map bags will be available at the Start.

**Size of the maps:**

1:10 000: 25 x 42 cm and 25 x 20 cm,

1:7500: 20 x 32 cm and 20 x 30 cm

Categories MW 10D, 12C, 14C, W40 and above, M45 and above, and the Open classes will use the map scaled 1:7.500.

All other classes will use the map scaled 1:10.000. Control descriptions are available on loose sheets in the start. Self service. They are NOT printed on the maps!

**Control punching system**

The control posts are equipped with electronic punching system (SportIdent) and the location is marked with small pieces of paper. If the control lamp does not flash please use the punch.

On the first day controls belonging to the Trail-O event will also be present on the competition terrain. These are marked with a blue stripes and they have no punching units on them.

**Refreshment points**

On courses longer than 10 km refreshment points will be provided. Their location is marked on the map.

**Open category**

Both the pre-entered and those entering on the day can start any time between the 60th minute and the end of the start period, leaving a minimum of 1 minute start interval. The Open class will also use the SPORTident electronic timing system: please punch the start box as you start! We will not prepare an Open start list, we will not add together the results of the two days and there will not be a result ceremony either. However, we will publish the Open results with all the other results.

There will be a **Children's race** on marked courses: Registration is open until 1 pm on Day 1 and 11 am on Day 2 in the Finish area.

**Lost competitors** proceeding North will reach a trainway bordering the terrain, or a fence, from where they can get to the Finish area. Please report to the Finish tent! The Finish can be contacted on 06-20-949-43-78, (+36-20-949-43-78 from a foreign mobile phone).

**Result ceremony** will start at 1.30 pm on Day 2.

**Other important information**

- We kindly would like to attract your attention to the fact that the competition terrain contains extreme detaild parts where accurate map reading is essential. Be careful! :-)
- There are some farm yards on the competition area. We tried to avoid going close to those that are guarded by dogs. In addition all farms were informed about the event.
- There may be open wells on a few old, ruined farm yards. Be careful, preferably avoid crossing these areas.
- The competition area is bordered by a military property from the north and there is one close to the finish area too. It is forbidden to go close to these or cross their fences.
- During the weekdays there are forestry operations in the competition area, take due care!
- Please also take care of the order and cleanliness of the accommodation venues and the Event Centre. Put all your rubbish in the designated containers and mobile toilets. Use only the toilets provided. Keep the accommodations and the event area as clean as you would like to find them.
- It is forbidden to smoke, make fires or use a naked flame anywhere in the competition terrain, in the Finish area or in the Parking.
- In order to safeguard the wild game in the forest, no dogs should be taken onto the competition area and please keep them on a lead in the Finish area as well!
- There is a buffet serving hot and cold food in the Finish area.
- On Day 2 the dr. Szentgyörgyi Imre Memorial OL event will be organised as the first round of OL championship of the employees and students of the post and communication industry and schools.
- The Slovak - Hungarian Veteran Competition will be organised again. Based on Day 1 results the best veteran competitors of the two countries will compete on Day 2.
- Every competitor takes part at their own risk.
